The regular City Council meeting was called to order by Alechia Neubauer @ 7:30 p.m. Present were council members Cindy DeBilt, Travis Sorenson and Troy Enga, Clerk of Court / Auditor: Christian Vorgitch and Chief of Police Al Schmidt.

October minutes are reviewed by City Council.

Motion to approve October Minutes by Troy, 2nd by Travis. All in favor. Motion carried.

Utilities are discussed by Christian. W/S/G payments are above average for the month.

Christian explains that Municode is almost done with their processes. They will be followed up with sometime this week.

The audit of the Court records is coming along. They will be done in a timely manner but at this time it is a work in process.

Motion to approve a Building Permit for Steven Halfrich by Travis, 2nd by Cindy. All in favor. Motion carried.

A citizen has complained about a neighbor running a business out of his home. The ordinances will be reviewed about this and will be discussed next time.

A Domestic Fowl Ordinance was brought up and will be discussed with the City Attorney.

A citizen came in to discuss an issue with their house flooding. This issue was caused by backed up sewer lines. The citizen states that it was caused by the City Main Sewer line. This issue was discussed with City Council as the citizen would like the City to pay for the bill to the plumber.

Motion to pay the \$400 plumbing bill to the Harshaws by Travis, 2nd by Troy. All in favor. Motion carried.

A Cemetery update was given and the City is currently waiting for a proposal/quote from Moore Engineering.

Direct Deposit is discussed at this time and Amy has researched those prices. Amy states she will have to purchase new software that will be too expensive and does not make sense for the City. They have too few employees to justify the price.
