Christian states E-Force is almost up and running. They will be ready by July.

Chief Schmidt gives police updates.

Officer Pinski will be deployed overseas for a short amount of time.

Officer Pinski wrote a Grant for Police Radios and received \$6,000 for new Police Radios that will be compliant with new State Program.

Josh Feil from Moore Engineering gives an update on the water main project. States the City of Berthold received roughly 35% funding for their project from the ARPA Federal Funding. Josh also presents a quote for the Wildrose Cemetery Plotting Project. City of Berthold Park Board will take the lead on the Wildrose Cemetery Project. The City of Berthold will be moving forward with the water project.

Two citizens from the City of Berthold came in to voice their complaints about a section of the water main line. They state the sewer line is backing up into their home periodically and would like to know some options from the City. The City advised they could bring a proposal for the City to review.

nCourt is discussed as they are not providing adequate customer service in a timely manner. The League of Cities recommends the City of Berthold change their payment processing system to GovCards. GovCards is discussed by the City Council.

Motion to approve Kenmare Newspaper as the official newspaper for the City of Berthold by Travis, 2nd by Cindy. All in favor. Motion carried.
